EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Dr. Mabrouk Mubarak Sleem is a prominent Sudanese politician, born in Kassala in 1958. He combined both academic and political work, earning a Bachelor's degree in Commerce from Damascus, and a Master's and Ph.D. in History and Civilization Studies from Al-Fateh University.

His political role emerged in the 1980s as a Member of Parliament and Political Bureau member of the Democratic Unionist Party. He went on to lead several political and military movements, including Fath Forces and Free Lions, and played a key role as one of the lead negotiators in the Eastern Sudan Peace Agreement of 2006.

He held ministerial positions between 2006 and 2018 in the Ministries of Transport, Roads and Bridges; Environment and Forests; and Animal Resources.
